Parent and Pupil Survey Feedback 2021



Each year, we conduct a survey with parents and with our pupils. We then look at areas that we can improve based on the results of the survey.

My child is happy at this school.	100%
My child feels safe at this school.	100%
The school makes sure its pupils are well behaved.	94%
My child has been bullied and the school dealt with the bullying quickly and effectively.	37% 53% don't know/child not bullied
The school makes me aware of what my child will learn during the year.	94%
When I have raised concerns with the school they have been dealt with properly.	97% 1.5% didn't know
Does your child have special educational needs and/or disabilities (SEND)? If yes, please answer the following question My child has SEND, and the school gives them the support they need to succeed.'	64% 28% didn't know or NA
The school has high expectations for my child.	90% 5% didn't know
My child does well at this school.	95% 1.5% didn't know
The school lets me know how my child is doing.	97%
There is a good range of subjects available to my child at this school.	95% 1.5% didn't know
My child can take part in clubs and activities at this school.	89% 8% didn't know or NA
The school supports my child's wider personal development.	92% 1.5% didn't know
I would recommend this school to another parent. (yes or no)	95%

So what can we do to improve?

- Make parents aware of what we do if there are instances of bullying. From the pupil survey, they think that we deal with instances of bullying well.
- Look at provision of SEN across school—are there any issues with school processes or external agencies and how can we improve this?
- Advertise clubs and activities that happen outside of school so that parents are aware of the opportunities available for their child.
