Homework at St Lawrence's will be sent out every week on a Friday.

We plan homework to support:

- **What the children have learnt in school**
- **Recycle some key skills and prepare them for good learning habits as they go through school and beyond**

Please find below an example of what a homework sheet looks like. These will vary slightly depending on the year group.

Reading - Fluent by Friday! Read your reading book daily and record in the reading record book when you have read. Rewards will be given out for daily reading and reading everyday for the week! 	Comments from the teacher

We have thought very carefully about the amount we provide and it's value so have limited it:

- **Reading activity**
- **Maths practise**
- **Spelling or Vocabulary practise.**

The activities should not take very long to complete - little and often is always best.

At the end of the week, the children complete a quiz or discussion to show they have been practising their skills so they do not need to hand anything in to the Class Teacher - unless they want to of course.

We ask all parents to support the homework that the children bring home. Getting into good habits now, will definitely help them when homework becomes more demanding in later years.
